From the Fordyce Bathhouse, follow the stairs up behind the Shell Fountain, follow the Grand Promenade to the left, and you'll see the trailhead on the right-hand side. Alternatively, join fellow NPTC members at the top of the mountain for the views from the peak trailhead located behind the Hot Springs Mountain Tower. After enjoying views from the top, take a leisurely walk back down and then enjoy more activities and talks in Hot Springs National Park and a group lunch in Hot Springs. The trail is 0.6 mi long with an elevation gain of 400 feet. It has a 12.6% grade and is initially paved before turning to gravel. Budget 45 min. heading up. **Cost: All Ages – Free**


